He scored eight goals and added six assists for 14 points in January and moved into 13th place with 72 goals and 76 assists for 148 points in 235 career games.

He needs three points to pass Kamil Kreps and John Hughes for 11th on the all-time points list, and three goals to overtake Kurt MacSweyn for seventh in that category.

Battalion head coach Stan Butler is closing on another milestone in this his 16th season in the Ontario Hockey League. Butler, who became only the fourth coach in OHL history to reach the 1,000-game plateau when the Troops defeated the visiting Oshawa Generals 3-1 on Feb. 10, 2011, finished January needing five wins to become the seventh to record 500 victories.

Butler had a won-lost-tied record of 495-505-65 in 1,065 games heading into February, looking to join George Burnett of the Belleville Bulls as the only active OHL coaches with 500 victories.
